

TOP 10 NEEDS of 2023



1 2023 Graduation Supplies \$1,974

Help our 94 graduates move on to middle school with a new pair of shoes, a new uniform, and school supplies.

2 Internet for 3 schools \$165/month

Many of our students' homes have no electricity, and their only access to the internet is at our schools.

3 Hygiene Supplies \$165/month

Many homes have no running water; the importance of having hygiene supplies is never greater.

4 Electricity for 3 schools \$180/month

Electricity is vital to our schools, from our computer classes to keeping the classroom fans on during the hot Cambodian days.

5 Staff Salary Increase \$375/month

SSF has its own staff working alongside government teachers: English and Computer Teachers, Librarians, Nurses, etc. With the cost of living continuing to rise drastically, we need to increase each staff member's salary by \$25/month to provide a more livable wage and to reflect the value they bring to our schools.



6 Building Repairs \$2,500/year

Our buildings lovingly take a beating and require regular repairs. We need our buildings to be a safe place for everyone to teach and learn.

7 School Bus \$334/month

Our bus transports our students to and from the middle school—a safer option on the difficult roads than bicycles. The community helps supplement gas, and SSF pays for the driver and bus maintenance.

8 Computers \$500 each

With the necessity of teaching computer literacy today, our computers continue to reach the end of their lives.

9 Social Security/Healthcare \$500/month

Cambodia has a new program of Social Security and health care for its citizens. As an employer of Cambodian staff, SSF is required to match the costs. It is a good opportunity for our staff, but also a new required expense in our budget.

10 General Operating Fund \$50-\$500/month

Our greatest need is to continue to fund our ongoing general operating expenses. These expenses include: the salaries of our non-teaching, but vital staff, including security guards, nurses, librarians, and accountants; and teaching supplies, landscaping, and campus maintenance.
